Local chambers are rated Accredited, 3-Stars, 4-Stars, or 5-Stars. State chambers are recognized as either Accredited State Chamber or Accredited State Chamber with Distinction. The final determination is made by the Accrediting Board, a committee of U.S. Chamber board members.

There are only 201 Accredited Chambers of Commerce in the United States. Of the 201, 19 are Accredited, 20 are 3-Star Accredited, 59 are 4-Star Accredited, 102 are 5-Star Accredited. In Iowa, there are three Accredited Chambers of Commerce. Urbandale, 5-Star, Burlington, 5-Star and Marshalltown, 4-Star. The Urbandale Chamber of Commerce has three of its four staff members with their Institute for Organizational Management (IOM) designation from the US Chamber of Commerce as well.
